The Ozaukee County Board of Canvass met Tuesday, April 13, 2021 in Room 118 of the Administration Center for the purpose of canvassing the April 6, 2021 Spring Election.

The Inspectors' Statement indicates the ballots were manually counted: 683. The voter lists were reconciled – 683 voters. The machine lost power at 12:30pm and just prior to it, at 12:27pm, the count was on at 283 voters per the Inspectors' Statement. After the machine was back up and running, it was discovered that the numbers were off. Other than the loss of power, the machine did not jam or malfunction in any way. There is no other explanation other than the machine malfunctioned and counted a ballot twice. The Board of Canvassers feels due diligence was done and accepted the results.
