APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Mark Roherty, meeting properly noticed. Kim Voeller confirmed. Tom Grabow moved for the adoption of the Agenda. Rick Nelson second, all ayes.

Rick Olig discussed the Power Point Quarterly informational slides he presented regarding YTD Statewide & County Crash Statistics, Community Maps Changes, Predictive Analytics, Mobilizations, Governor's Conference, Upcoming Events - specific discussion on 2022 Speed Awareness Day & BOTS DRE School, Legislative Updates, & Data Requests.

Local Information Items:

Jon Edgren passed out a speed study map handout for CTH Q – I43 to CTH C for review, recapped the data, and then turned the discussion over to guest Jim Bohn.

Guest Comments:

Jim Bohn – Voiced his concern again regarding the 55 mph speed limit on Ulao Rd. He noted that nearby roads (Hwy 167 & Pioneer Rd) are all at 45 mph. Discussion followed.

ACTION ITEMS: Speed Study of Cth Q – Ulao Rd; reducing speed from 55 mph to 45 mph

Rick Nelson made a motion to reduce the speed of that stretch of road from 55 mph to 45 mph, at the request of a concerned citizen. Judge Chris Ohlis second; Vote of Members: 9 Ayes, 1 Nay; Motion carried. This motion will now be presented at the Public Works meeting and then the County Board meeting.

Discussion followed on the definition of the 85th percentile concept.
