CJCC Meeting Minutes- November 15, 2022

The Criminal Justice Collaborating Council met in the Sheriff's Office- Lobby Conference Room of the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office on 11.15.2022

Call to Order/Proper Notice/Adoption of Agenda:

Chair, Judge Paul Malloy called the meeting to order at 1:16pm

Approval of Minutes:

Did not have a quorum to vote on November's meeting minutes.

Coordinator Report:

The health department is combining both counties into one coalition for all out priority areas; Substance Use, Sexual Health and Wellness and Mental Health.

Chris Herren is coming to speak in November at Concordia. It's free to the public. He was an NBA star that struggled with addiction and now shares his story across the country.

Financial Report:

We have \$32,000 to spend. We voted on Sirona's Taxi Vouchers, which totaled \$500. We called Liza Drake to get quorum to be able to vote on the vouchers.

We discussed that we will collect proposals from committee members and the general community on ways to spend the funds and review/vote on them next meeting. Proposals are due to Ashley Claussen on January 31st by 4pm.

Current Statistics

173 total cases in Diversion/DPA program to date

7 current cases at present

- 100% of current participants are working with Sirona Recovery staff to address their criminogenic risks and needs

- 100% of participants have created a case plan with the staff, based on mutually established goals and priorities

TAD Program Admissions/Discharges: Current Period

- 4 Graduations
- 0 Non-compliance terminations
- 1 Pending potential admissions
- 1 New Admissions

Program Graduations vs. Termination Rates to Date

- 112 total program graduations (65%): successfully completed all program conditions throughout the monitoring period
- 54 total non-compliance terminations (34%): majority of terminations due to positive drug tests

Recidivism Rates of Discharged cases: all present & past programs

- 202 total program participant discharges
- Diversion/DPA
- 166 total discharged cases to date
- 136 former participants have not committed additional crimes since discharge (82%)
- 30 former participants have committed additional crimes since discharge (18%)

ATR

- 37 Total discharged cases to date
- 26 former participants have not committed additional crimes since discharge (71%)
- 11 former participants have committed additional crimes since discharge (29%)
