Call to Order/Proper Notice/Adoption of Agenda:

Chair, Adam Gerol called the meeting to order at 11:33pm.

Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made by Judge Ohlis to approve the May 8th, 2023, meeting minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Heather Dvoran.

Coordinator Report:

Vending Machines- We have confirmed a location in Washington County. Moraine Park Technical College in West Bend is going to house the machine. It will have Narcan, Fentanyl Test Strips and Condoms in it. Waiting to hear from the non-profit centers board this week on if they will take a machine for Ozaukee. Probation and Parole hand out Narcan and Fentanyl Test Strips.

We discussed if there are better locations for the machine. For right now, we are going to wait to hear from the non-profit center and then go from there.

Change the ending campaign has officially begun in Ozaukee County. The health department now owns that site and has been promoting it. There is a billboard right on HWY 32 heading towards downtown Port Washington. Please continue to advertise the campaign.

DPA Referrals:

Melissa from Sirona Recovery spoke about the TAD program and their referrals. They have seen a huge decrease in referrals going down. The application process for the next year is coming up and Liza is wondering if we should change the application around a little to see if we can get more referrals. The consensus is the TAD program is a great benefit to Ozaukee County and they don't want to see it go away. Adam, DA, mentioned that they like to refer people to organizations that they work closely with, so he will talk to some people and see how they can get more referrals.

Financial Report:

**Ozaukee County TAD Program Recidivism Rates: Diversion/DPA Program
May 9, 2023 – August 21, 2023****Current Statistics**

182 total cases in Diversion/DPA program to date

8 current cases at present

TAD Program Admissions/Discharges: Current Period

- 2 Graduations
- 2 Non-compliance terminations
- 1 Pending potential admission; screened and found eligible
- 5 New admissions
- 4 Recent Diversion referrals

Program Graduations vs. Termination Rates to Date

- 118 total program graduations (68%): successfully completed all program conditions throughout the monitoring period
- 56 total non-compliance terminations (32%): majority of terminations due to positive drug tests

Recidivism Rates: Diversion/DPA & ATR programs**Diversion/DPA: 2015 - present**

- 174 total discharged cases to date
- 56 participants recidivated while in the TAD program (32% recidivism rate)
- Only 6 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program (3.4% recidivism rate)

ATR: 2017 - 2019

- 34 total discharged cases to date
- 17 participants recidivated while in the TAD program (50% recidivism rate)
- Only 5 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program (14.7% recidivism rate)



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CJCC Updates:

The PSAs are almost complete, they just have one left. Was hoping to share on large screen at this meeting, but screen wasn't working. Ashley will send them out for committee to see. Will send an email when they are all done and ready to be distributed. The funds that were used to create these PSAs was just for the creation of the videos.
