Lt Arndt discussed the week long speed study done on Main St & Chestnut in Belgium from May 11th – May 19th. He explained the Radar Anomalies that he felt took place, and noted that the data shows there is no specific speeding problem at this location.

There will be at least 4 speed studies discussed at the October meeting.

State Informational Items:

Dave Brantner stated that the I43 Reconstruction project is still on-going and on schedule. The Hwy C bridge is being reconstructed and will most likely be closed till the end of the year. The Mequon Road ramp will not begin until Spring of 2024.
