The Ozaukee County Board of Canvass met Friday, February 23, 2024 in Room 118 of the Administration Center for the purpose of canvassing the February 20, 2024 Spring Primary Election.

Meeting called to order at 8:00 am.

Present: County Clerk Niemuth, Patti Spencer, Carol Boettcher and Chief Deputy County Clerk Henning.

Oath of Office given to Patti Spencer and Carol Boettcher by County Clerk Niemuth.

County Clerk Niemuth reviewed the steps taken to prepare for the County Board of Canvassers. The Board of Canvass accepted the information.

The Inspectors' Statement indicated one (1) absentee ballot was rejected as the certificate envelope looked tampered with. The Board of Canvassers questioned the reason for rejection as "looks tampered with" is a vague description. The Board of Canvassers opened the Certificate of Rejected Absentee Ballot Envelope (EL-102) which contained the one (1) rejected ballot. The Board of Canvassers concurred that the certificate envelope appears to have been opened and resealed and that the ballot was rejected properly. The Board of Canvassers placed the certificate envelope into a new Certificate of Rejected Absentee Ballot Envelope (EL-102).
