TAD Report:

**Ozaukee County TAD Program Recidivism Rates: Diversion/DPA Program
November 27, 2023 – May 13, 2024**

Current Statistics

189 total cases in Diversion/DPA program to date

7 current cases at present

TAD program admissions/discharges: current period

- 5 graduations
- 0 Non-compliance terminations (1 pending termination)
- 2 New admissions
- 15 Referrals during the last period

Recidivism Rates: Diversion/DPA & ATR programs

Diversion/DPA: 2015-present

- 185 total discharges cases to date
- 57 participants recidivated while in the TAD program (32% recidivism rate)
- Only 6 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program (3.4% recidivism rate)

ATR: 2017-2019

- 34 total discharged cases to date
- 17 participants recidivated while in the TAD program (50% recidivism rate)
- Only 5 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program (14.7% recidivism rate)

CJCC Updates

- Sheriff Knowles reports Narcan availability for law enforcement is a non-issue for partner agencies. Many agencies have stepped up and offered to assist as needed.
