29 Ms. Buechler discussed this report breaks down all the communicable diseases reported to the
30 health department by county each month. Overall, the report typically follows the same trends
31 year after year.

33 **WIC PROGRAM REPORT**

34 Ms. Buechler stated the WIC report is another standing report update at each meeting. Ms.
35 Buechler reported the farmers market voucher checks will transition from paper to an eWIC card
36 in 2025. Due to the continued increase in WIC caseload, increasing staff hours is being
37 considered.

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39 **PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTOR UPDATES**

40 Ms. Buechler reported the health department sent out a letter to licensed daycare facilities in
41 Washington and Ozaukee County regarding information for lead and water testing. The health
42 department has received around 10 responses with interest in the program and we are working
43 with DHS to implement a plan for testing. Ms. Buechler discussed the health department had its
44 4th annual Community Connections event on June 4th. 72 WIC families (164 children) in
45 Ozaukee County and 128 WIC families (299 children) received information from other
46 community partners along with their farmers market vouchers.
