TAD Report:

**Ozaukee County TAD Program Recidivism Rates: Diversion/DPA Program
May 13, 2024 – August 12, 2024**

Current Statistics

201 total cases in Diversion/DPA program to date

14 current cases at present

TAD Program Admissions/Discharges: Current Period

- 1 graduation
- 2 non-compliance terminations
- 9 new admissions during the last period
- 14 referrals during the last period

Diversion/DPA: 2015 – present

- 187 total discharged cases to date
- 59 participants recidivated while in the TAD programs (32% recidivism rate)
- Only 9 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program (5% recidivism rate)

ATR: 2017 – 2019

- 34 total discharged cases to date
- 17 participants recidivated while in the TAD program (50% recidivism rate)
- Only 6 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program (17.6% recidivism rate)

Case Study, Success Story, and Testimonials shared out, as well as satisfaction with the program to date:

- 89% of participants strongly agree that this program helped them better understand their thinking and attitudes around alcohol and drug use
- 100% of participants agree that they learned some useful new skills in this program
- 100% of participants agree that they have more decision-making tools now than before they were in the program
