

**COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS
SPRING ELECTION & PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE VOTE
APRIL 2, 2024**

The Ozaukee County Board of Canvass met Monday, April 8, 2024 in Room 118 of the Administration Center for the purpose of canvassing the April 2, 2024 Spring Election and Presidential Preference Vote.

Meeting called to order at 8:00 am.

Present: County Clerk Niemuth, Patti Spencer, Kathy Broghammer, Deputy County Clerk Quaas and Chief Deputy County Clerk Henning.

Oath of Office given to Kathy Broghammer by County Clerk Niemuth.
