19 **COMMUNICABLE DISEASE REPORT**

20 Ms. Buechler reported the health department is seeing an increase in Pertussis cases which is
21 normal for this time of year. The health department is continuing to work with families and
22 healthcare providers to educate about Pertussis and the benefits of vaccination. Ms. Buechler
23 stated the health department is still monitoring one active TB case and the individual was
24 recently released from isolation.

26 **WIC PROGRAM REPORT**

27 Ms. Buechler stated WIC continues to see an increase in their caseload. The health department's
28 request for a part-time WIC nutritionist has been approved and the hiring process for this
29 position will start in January. Recently, WIC started utilizing a new online tool for families to
30 complete their education requirements.

32 **PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTOR UPDATES**

33 Ms. Buechler discussed the quarter three report regarding the Change the End and lead poisoning
34 prevention campaigns. Funding for both campaigns ends at the end of the year and the health
35 department will begin managing the related websites in-house to continue both campaigns into
36 2025.

38 Ms. Buechler reported the health department will be revisiting current Food & Recreational
39 Licensing fee structure in 2025 if needed, due to potential changes coming at the state level.

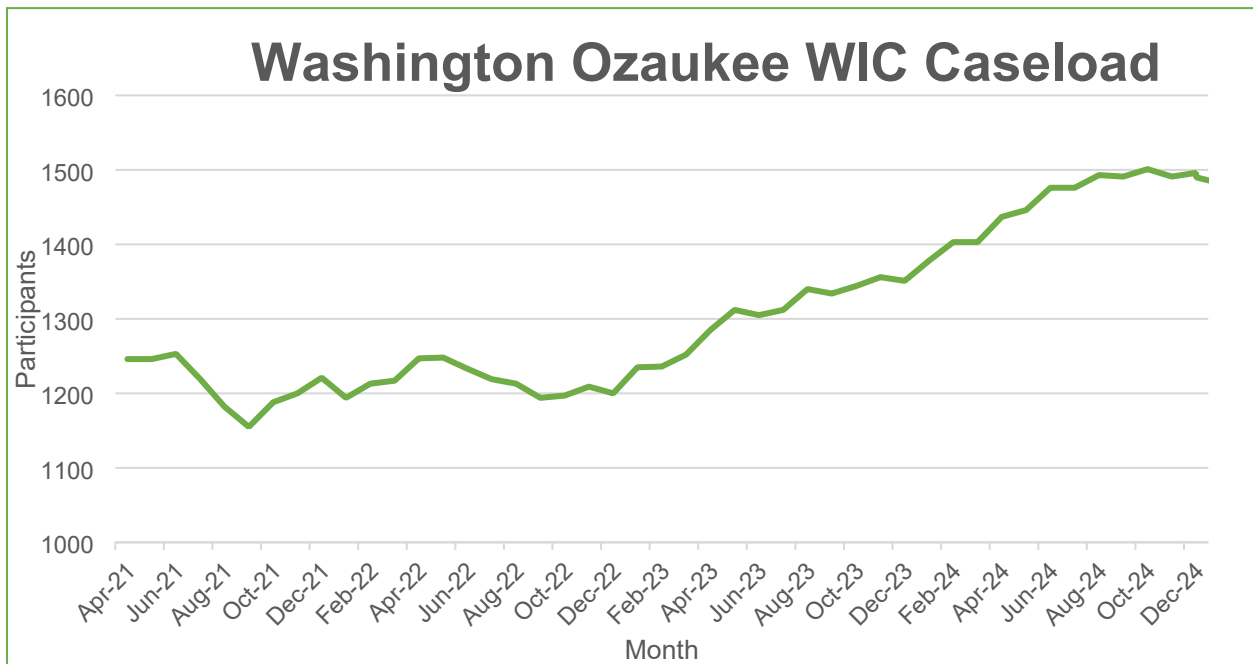
