ACTION ITEMS: SPEED STUDY

Jon Edgren addressed the studies as follows:

Cty Hwy H/Hwy A/Fredonia Avenue

Fredonia Marshal, DPW and the Planning and Parks committee requested a review of speed in specified location. The locations have pictures included

- Speed study fell well into the 85% of drivers at posted speed or less
- No vehicular accidents occurred between 2017 to date
- Minimal patrol requests per Lt Arndt
- No changes are recommended at this time, but it will be addressed to the Public Works committee to complete the process.

Cty T/Lakefield Road

Resident requested speed study due to increased traffic and speeds

- 2025 speed study showed slight increase from 2020 speed study and no cause for speed limit change
- Flashing stop signs have decreased accidents
- No action recommended at this time
- Information shared with resident

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Quarterly Review of Fatal Accidents: Lt Brad Arndt

- One double fatal accident for this quarter double fatal, wrong way driver
- 3 victims: 2 fatal and 1 multiple serious injury
- Awaiting toxicology results per Ian Luecke of Medical Examiner's office

State Informational Items:

Mark Borck, Traffic Regulations Engineer, Guest

- I43 open with some items remaining items to be completed
- Mequon Road/WIS 167 improvements are ongoing and finished by end of 2025

Captain Hoell stated per DOT, Highland Road ramp/4 way stop to install overhead lights for better visibility

Todd Rasmussen discussed the Power Point Quarterly informational slides (*Power Point presentation is attached*)

- 285 fatalities, 266 crashes for the year per Monday, July 21st, 2025
- Wrong Way Driving - Together we can save lives
 - New commission group to combat wrong way drivers
 - Complete driver action on Crash report
 - "Right at night" stay in right lane whenever possible
 - Recommending social media marketing
- Community Maps-QR code to access Zoom meeting
 - Provides a statewide map of all police reported crashes
- Phlebotomy program for LEO on the road or in the jail
- Emergency contact for Driver's license
 - Voluntary and private information
 - Resource for LEO in the case of emergency
- Proposed legislation
