14 Chairperson Schulteis called the meeting to order at 8:30 am. Notice of Posting was given.

16 **MEETING MINUTES**

17 No corrections were made to the minutes. The minutes are approved.

18
19 **COMMUNICABLE DISEASE REPORT**

20 Ms. Buechler explained that the report follows trends from previous years, outlined its structure,
21 and provided an overview of the diseases reported to the health department. Ms. Buechler further
22 reported that the health department is closely monitoring measles cases in Wisconsin.

23
24 **WIC PROGRAM REPORT**

25 Ms. Buechler discussed the WIC breastfeeding report in Washington and Ozaukee Counties,
26 noting both counties are higher than the state average. WIC benefit redemption is high, with
27 record participation in the program being attributed to increased outreach efforts, as well as
28 retention of currently enrolled participants. Ms. Buechler reported the 2025 Farmers Market
29 Nutrition Program grant had funding changes this year and only 75% of typically allocated
30 checks were received this year. Lastly, the health department WIC Director, Missy Lacy will be
31 presenting at the virtual National WIC Association conference on how Wisconsin WIC
32 modernized and streamlined breast pump management and issuance.

34 **NEW MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS**

35 The board welcomed Washington County Supervisor Marietta Bailey as the newest member of
36 the Joint Board of Health. Board member Bailey briefly introduced herself and highlighted her
37 background.

38
39 **PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTOR UPDATES**

40 Ms. Buechler discussed her report that highlighted some of the events the health department has
41 been working on over the past few months. In addition to the report, Ms. Buechler reported the
42 health department recently applied for some competitive grants for 2026 and the health
43 department has no significant changes to the 2026 budget. Lastly, a press release was
44 disseminated regarding the creation of the Fatality Review Team. This effort between
45 Washington and Ozaukee Counties will gather agencies to review overdose and suicide fatalities.
46 The overall objective is to reduce fatalities, identify gaps in services, and to find areas of

1 improvement in participating agencies. The Fatality Review team is tentatively set to launch in
2 January.

5 The next Joint Board of Health meeting is scheduled for November 14, 2025 at 8:30 am, at the
6 Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department in Washington County.

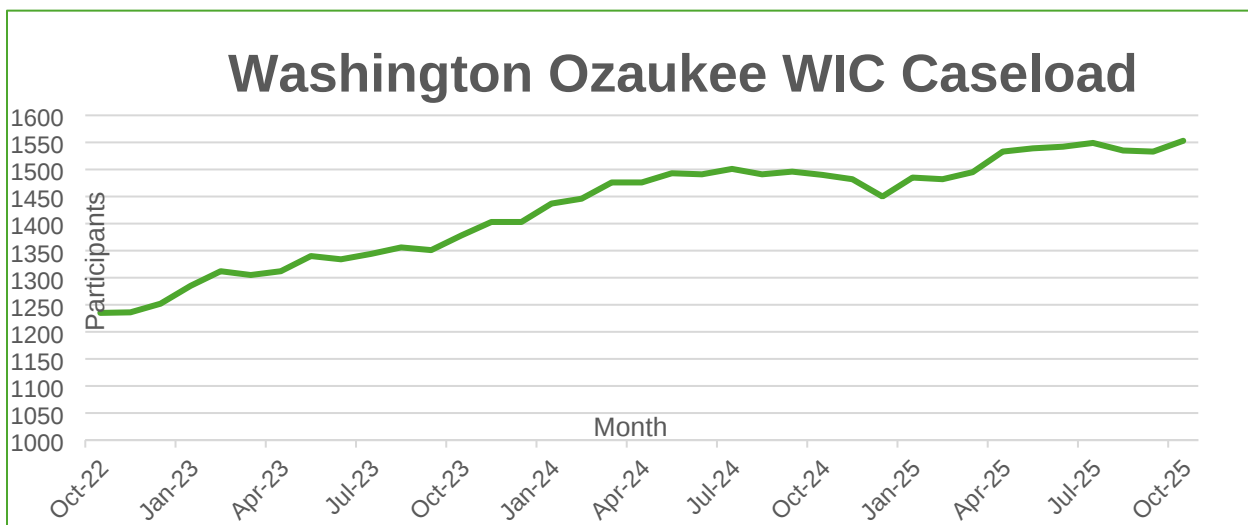

*October and November 2025 data not yet published, but State WIC office verbally stated redemptions have been increasing since Government shutdown and Food Share benefit delays starting November 1st and have been monitoring closely.



Updates from WIC and Government shutdown

- Federal Government shutdown and November benefit status: Wisconsin WIC remains available: Wisconsin's federally funded WIC program remains available during the federal government shutdown. WIC benefits will be available throughout the month of November. Participants are encouraged to use WIC benefits and attend WIC appointments. Wisconsin WIC is monitoring the federal government shutdown and funding for WIC closely.
- Fiscal Year 2026 (Starting October 1st) Temporary funding is coming from different sources including:
 - Nutrition Services Admin and Food Funds (Spend Forward Funds up to 3%)
 - Formula Rebate Funds
 - National Contingency Funds
 - 2025 Reallocation Funds
 - Section 32 Funds from Farm Bill used for WIC for the first time in history
 - Second round of Section 32 Funds allocated to WIC in the first week of November
